Club Rules Code of Conduct

Club Player

As a South Auckland Rangers Football Club Player, you should meet the following requirements regarding your conduct during any South Auckland Rangers sanctioned activity:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be professional in and accept responsibility for your actions.
- Make a commitment to providing quality service and performance.
- Be aware of, and maintain, an uncompromising adherence to standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- Operate within the Constitution, Regulations, Policies and Procedures of South Auckland Rangers AFC, NZF and NRF.
- Understand the possible consequences of breaching the NZF/NRF Club Rules Code of Conduct and Policies.
- Refrain from any form of abuse towards others.
- Refrain from using any obscene language.
- Refrain from any form of discrimination and victimisation towards others.
- Reject corruption, drugs, racism, violence and other dangers to our sport.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Be a positive role model.
- Do not participate (or benefit from assisting others involved) in sports betting or gambling activity associated with football matches and/or football results in which you are participating or have been directly involved in.

A player will:

- Play to win but play fair.
- Never argue with or verbally abuse an official, football and club officials; observe the Laws of the Game.
- Accept defeat with dignity.



- Conduct themselves in a sportsman-like manner and respect fellow players, coaches, managers and referees and the achievement of opponents.
- Not bully or take an unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with the coach, manager teammates and opponents.
- A player must only play for a team within the South Auckland Rangers Club for which they are registered in the club database and for which they are eligible
- All players are responsible for the fines which they receive as stated in the Club's
