Club Rules Job Description

Coach

Responsible to: Club Board

This is a voluntary position and with the assistance of the Team Manager and/or co-coach, provides training, mentoring, and delivery of the game to the team allocated to you.

Communicate positively and effectively to your players and parents (where applicable) ensuring all training, games and development opportunities are offered and participation encouraged.

All disciplinary action, complaints, requests or enquiries must be dealt with promptly and in a positive manner and reported to the club accordingly

Responsibilities and Duties:

A Coach should be:

- Planning and managing age-appropriate training sessions
- Supervising and managing players in competition
- Developing technical, tactical and life skills of the players you are coaching
- Managing resources and equipment in conjunction with the Team Manager
- Building a positive, supportive and inclusive team environment that provides for all participants enjoyment, success and challenge
- Being a role model and providing leadership
- Ensuring the health and safety of the athletes you are coaching
- Following all aspects of the Northern Region Football and South Auckland Rangers AFC Codes of Conduct and any other club policies as they relate
- Be available to players and parents as required in the delivery and coaching of the game
- Communicate positively with opposition coaches, manager and game officials before, during and after the game
- Discuss any challenges and concerns that you have with the club officials so they can be resolved in a timely positive manner
- Ensure players selected are registered with the club in the club's database system and are eligible for the grade in which they are selected.
- In the absence of the Coach, the Team Manager will complete these responsibilities accordingly (refer to Team Manager job description)
- Meet all South Auckland Rangers AFC reporting requirements as they become due or are requested. Review own position description to ensure accuracy and submit potential changes to the Club Board
- The club will undertake Police Vetting of all Coaches as required.

Skills Required:

- Understand the characteristics and needs of the player's you coach
- Understand the components of a training session and of competitions relevant to the players being coached
- Understand the laws of the game and any age-related variances
- Appropriate communication, management and coaching skills for the players being coached
- Highly motivated and committed to the team for the duration of the season
