South Auckland Rangers Association Football & Sports Club Club Rules Policy Document Payment of Club Membership Fees and Fines for Red and Yellow Cards

Objectives.

South Auckland Rangers Football Club requires payment of all Membership Fees prior to the commencement of the season for every player, junior and senior

Part payments are accepted

This document outlines the club's policy in relation to the responsibility for payment of fines relating to the issue of yellow or red cards.

Requirements.

Payment Of Club Membership Fees may be made by any of the following methods.

- Via the registration system when entering your registration for the upcoming season
- Online banking into the club's bank account
- Training night every Thursday, club open for payments. Cash and Eftpos available

The club does allow for part payment of fees on a regular basis until fully paid. In extreme circumstances this will be approved by the Treasurer. Full payment must be made by June 30th in the current year.

Payment of Red and Yellow Cards, are required as follows

- 1. Senior Team Players, Coaches or Managers
 - All fines relating to the issue of yellow or red cards must be paid for by the player, coach or coaching support person who received the card.
- 2. All Junior and Youth Team Players, Coaches or Managers
 - Any fines relating to the issue of yellow or red cards must be paid for by the player, coach or coaching support person who received the card.
- 3. Due date for payment of fines
 - All fines must be paid within 14 days of the date of issuing a fine invoice.
 Payment must be paid into the club bank account.

Senior Teams include all men's and women's senior teams who are not included in the definition of Performance Teams above.
